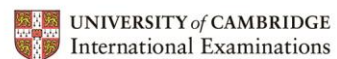

The curriculum is designed by Cambridge University in England and the exams are set and marked there. The system has been successfully taught all around the world and is internationally recognized. South African universities see it as a more rigorous set of exams than the National Senior Certificate and award higher points for equivalent passes in the Cambridge system.
